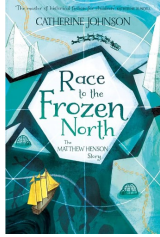

Geography Key Knowledge

A map is a symbolic representation of a place. They show the sizes and shapes of places and where features are in relation to others. Compass points tell us the direction.

There are four cardinal compass points- north, south, east and west and then four ordinal directions: north west, north east, south east and south west. A grid reference gives you a precise location on a map.

The four figure grid reference is always for the bottom left hand corner of the square

James Cook was an explorer and cartographer.

Hawaii is in the Northern Hemisphere

Australia has deserts, mountains, beaches and rainforests

New Zealand has mountains, volcanoes, beaches, fjords and glaciers

Hawaii is a volcanic island. It has volcanoes, beaches and bamboo forests.
