We then ask that families leave the hall and exit school via the red key stage 2 cloakroom doors and through the gate near the Nursery and Reception classrooms. At the start of the display, we will have a collection bucket and welcome any donations to our chosen charity, Compton Care. Thanks to everyone who donated Christmas jumpers and came to the sale on Monday – we are looking forward to sending off all donations in time for Christmas.
